Small businesses that are limited companies based in the Holme Valley are encouraged to express interest in Fund for ideas that can boost sustainability and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

What is the BGBF Offering?

BGBF is offering small grants to limited companies to help explore innovative new ideas and take successful green businesses a step further in their development. If your business has ambitions to deliver something new for climate conscious customers or you would like support expanding existing work, then keep in touch with the application process by completing the Expression of Interest Form using the link below. We would expect businesses to make a contribution to the overall cost of the project.

What the application process involves

Once you have expressed interest you will be added to the BGBF contacts list and sent a full application form link when the Fund opens on the 19th May 2023. There will be an opportunity to discuss your idea and application with the BGBF team before the applications deadline to check your idea meets the Fund criteria and to ask any questions you may have. Decisions on grants are expected by the end of August 2023.

What to do next?

Your business must be a limited company based in the Holme Valley to apply. The BGBF will favour applications that:

- Demonstrate strong commitment to delivering environmental benefits.
- Provide a dedicated single point of contact.
- Have a clear business plan.
