Introduction

The Bright Green Business Fund, which distributes grants from the 'HoTTWind@Longley' Community Turbine in Hade Edge, is interested in exploring the possibility of facilitating renewable energy projects in the Holme Valley. The Fund would like to hear from local installers and contractors interested in applying for a grant contribution towards developing aspects of their Renewable Energy work.

What is the BGBF Offering?

BGBF is offering the opportunity for limited companies to apply for small grants to help explore potential new business ideas that increase renewable power generation in the Holme Valley. If your business has ambitions to expand existing renewables work or develop something new involving ground source heat, solar power, small scale wind etc then you can keep in touch with the application process by completing an Expression of Interest Form using the link below. We would expect businesses to make a contribution to the overall cost of the project.

What the application process involves

If you complete the link below the BGBF team will send you a full application form link when the Fund opens on the 19th May 2023. There will be an opportunity to discuss your idea and application with the team before the deadline to check your idea meets the Fund criteria and to ask any questions you may have. Decisions on grants are expected by the end of August 2023.

What to do next?

Your business must be a limited company based in the Holme Valley to apply. The BGBF will favour ideas that:

- Demonstrate commitment to increasing renewable energy generation in the Holme Valley.
- Provide a dedicated single point of contact.
- Have a clear business plan.
